Females - darker blue with black

Frontwing margin

Favorite plant: Low-bush Blueberry

Eastern Pine Elfin *Callophrys niphon*

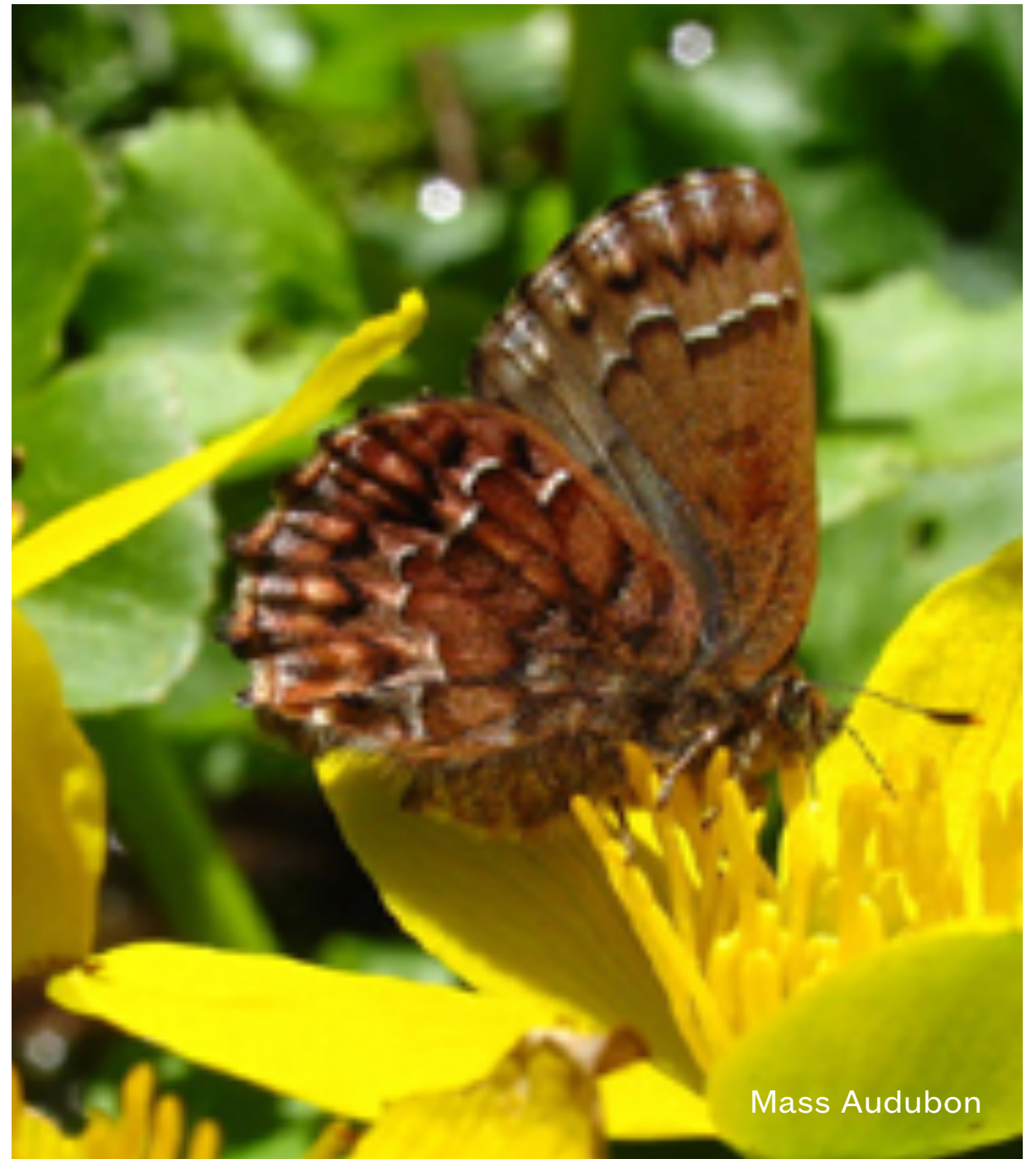
Wingspan: about 1 inch

Color: Brown/Orange with boldly patterned hindwing with blackish bands crossing the veins

Favorite Plant: White Pine

Common habitat: Woodland Edge/
Shrub Border

Color: White with dusky forewing tips
