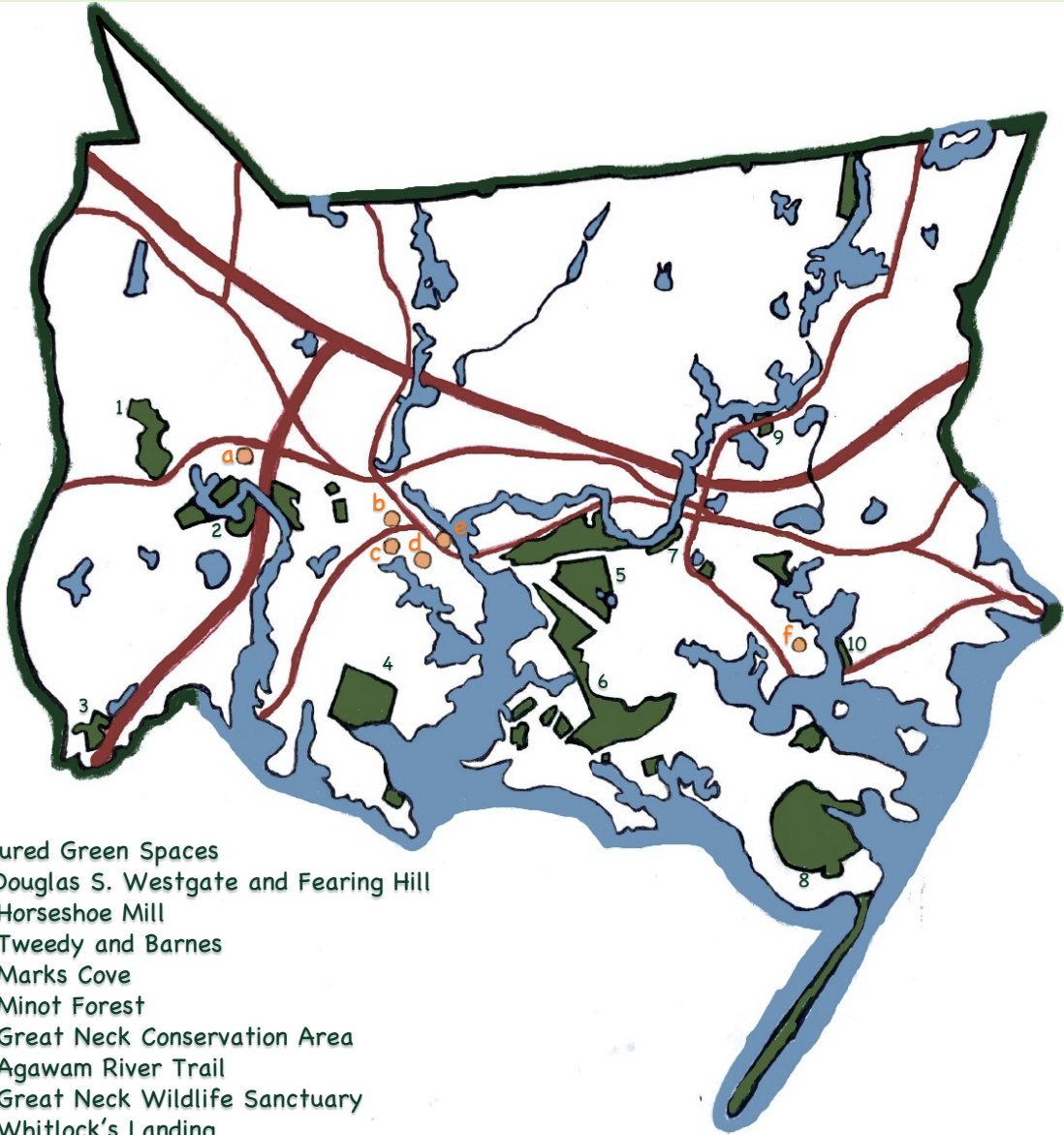

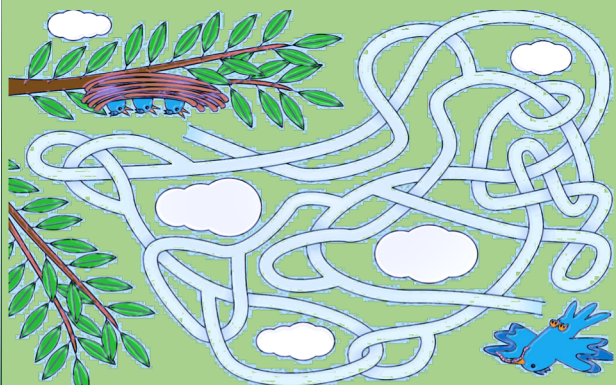

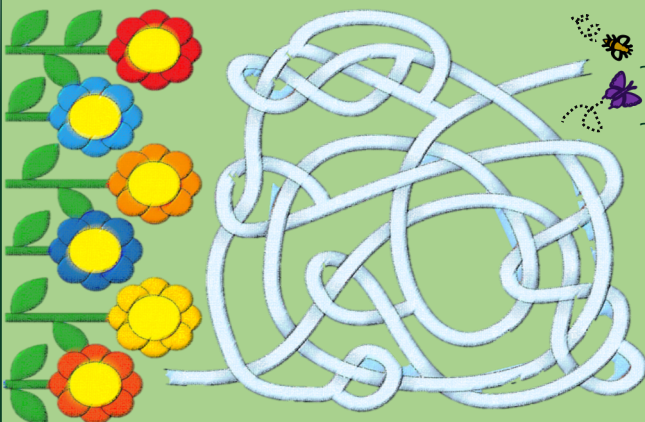

Look around... Can you find something in nature that is your favorite color? What is it?



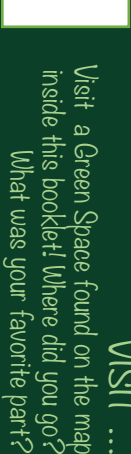
LISTEN ...
